## FROM THE PASTOR

### Communication and the Ministry of First Baptist Church

When we face a crisis, many of us say to ourselves, "I don't want to bother anyone else, I'll handle this myself." Such a noble attitude is commendable, but there are times in our lives when we need the body of Christ to minister to us. It is also a privilege for us to minister to one another in times of need.

A challenge for many congregations is one of communicating the needs of members who are going through crisis. I know that in my time here at First Baptist Church, we have learned about some of our members going through a challenging time after the crisis was over. I know that our church staff, Deacons and Sunday School leadership want to respond to needs of our church family. Here are some practical actions that we can take to help improve communication.

**1. If you know of someone who has a need, please call our church, or a staff member.**

It will help us if you take the initiative to communicate with us about a need. I know that all of us on our staff are careful to make sure that a need is not confidential before communicating with others. Our church office is open Monday until Thursday from 8:30 AM until 4:30 PM, and Fridays from 8:30 AM to 1 PM. We are changing our times for our administrative staff. Mrs. Pat Pierce will be working moving from 40 to 32 hours and not be in our office on Monday. She has voluntarily moved from full time to part time compensation. Mrs. Hubbard will be here by herself on Mondays, and Mrs. Pat Pierce on Fridays. There are some times when we get multiple phone calls during office hours when only one person is here. If you leave a message, someone will call back that day. Like everything today, email is the quickest way to communicate. I check mine every couple of hours. My email is Dhedgepeth@aol.com.

**2. If a crisis occurs on weekends, please call the Pastor or Associate Pastor at home.**

Tommy and I are careful to make sure that one of us are always available. We also communicate with our Deacons if we are going to be out of town. My home number is 877-3031, and I am in all the new phone books since 2009. I have a problem with cell phone service where I live, so it would be better to call at home and leave a message. I would rather you call than assume we know about a need. If someone calls the church on Friday afternoon, it is possible that message will not be received until Sunday morning.

**3. Contact your Deacon, or Deacon of the week to inform them about the need.**

Our Deacons want to serve our church in ministry. They are eager to be with members of our congregation when they face a crisis. It will be a great encouragement to them if you will let them know about a need. They will respond.

**4. Contact your Sunday School class.**

The purpose of a Sunday School class/small group is not only teaching, but ministry and outreach. They also want to respond when a need occurs in the life of a member. Contact someone in your Sunday School class if a crisis occurs.

Your help in the ministry to others (the purpose of ministry) will help us grow and transition in the coming weeks, months, and years. Thanks for your help as we seek to move forward in fulfilling His purpose through First Baptist Church.

Your faithfulness in our "Catch Up" Sunday is commendable and witness to the faithfulness of our Lord Jesus through His people. Thanks for trusting Him. Blessings, Danny Hedgepeth
